| <b>Brief Description Of Decision</b>   | Approval of the School Admissions Policy for Community & Voluntary Controlled Schools 2023/24, the Co-ordinated Admission Schemes 2023/24 and the Published Admission Numbers (PAN's) for 2023/24.   |
| <b>Reason(s) For Decision</b>  | The School Admissions Code of Practice makes it a mandatory requirement for admission authorities to determine their admission arrangements annually. Consultation has taken place to extend the current period a child remains on the waiting list to the whole of the relevant academic year and to reduce the PAN at Crophorne-with-Charlton CE First School from 18 to 15.                                 |
| <b>Alternative Options Considered And Rejected</b>   | Full public consultation took place. No responses were received to the consultation. The proposals are not significantly different to the policy for Community and Voluntary Controlled Schools in Worcestershire or the co-ordinated schemes which have been previously agreed. The PAN reduction at Crophorne-with-Charlton CE First School does not impact on the sufficiency of school places in the area. |
