Brief Description Of Decision	The Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Children and Families:  (a) notes the changes made by the Department for Education (DfE) for the funding of Early Years (EY) for 2, 3 and 4 year olds from April 2017, including the national policy to increase the free entitlement to 30 hours from September 2017 for working parents;  (b) notes the DfE new national allocation formula for the EY Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) and the positive impact for Worcestershire in providing significant additional EY DSG;  (c) has regard to the consultation undertaken in January and February 2017;  (d) notes the consultation feedback in Appendices 2 and 3;  (e) notes the involvement of the Worcestershire Schools Forum (WSF) members and EY providers during the consultation;  (f) notes the views of the WSF on the proposals for a new Early Years Single Funding Formula (EYSFF)
