Brief Description Of Decision	The Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Adult Social Care:
	(a) approved the business case from Altiom as attached to the report and agreed the £199k funding of New Technologies in Care as identified in the report for Howbury House, to deliver the cashable benefits outlined below; and
	(b) authorised the Director to take all necessary steps to put (a) into effect.
Reason(s) For	As set out in the report.
Decision	To sign off the business case for the funding of innovative technology to be used at Howbury. This is in line with the delegated authority afforded to the Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Adult Social Care as per the original Cabinet decision (19 Nov 2015). The technology will help to improve the outcomes and experience for people in receipt of Council-funded Care at Howbury House. The approach will also enable the delivery of savings for the Council which may come directly from a reduced cost of care or avoidance of expenditure on more expensive placements elsewhere.
