What's gone well since last report?

- Supported living Commissioners have been working with a Aspire and Dimensions since the last meeting to take on several supported living houses across the county from Macintyre and Radis, who have chosen to give their support packages back. This has been successful, and the support has now started.
- The new supported living dynamic purchasing system contract is in the final stages of evaluation, and we hope to be able to share the outcomes of this at the next meeting.
- Ourway shared that they have helped someone to move into their own privately rented property. The funding for their Housing project has now ended but they continue to help with housing issues where they are able.
- Commissioners are in conversations with several property providers across Worcestershire to source a range of new

supported living services to meet future demands. These include flats, adapted bungalows, shared houses and single properties.



What will we have looked at by next report?

- By the next report Sam will have visited Bishop's place and asked the tenants their feelings about living there as part of the planned pathway planning team reviews.



Problems and Risks

(Actual or potential problems and risks to be considered before the next reporting period)

- Carers have raised issues in regard to healthy eating / healthy lifestyles in a number of supported living services and the long-term risks to people's health.
- Both carers and expert members raised the issue about a lack of safe spaces for people to access.
- Since our last meeting the housing project officer post has been vacant meaning a lack of capacity for some of the lighter touch housing and supported living issues as well as some of the demand mapping for young adults.
