

## Who is this course aimed at?

This is a language course suitable for those who already have significant experience (120+ tutored hours) of learning French and wish to progress towards further fluency and accuracy.

## What will I need?

No formal qualifications required to join but prior knowledge essential.

## Programme Aims

This course is designed to build on your prior knowledge and develop confidence for communicating in a wide range of contexts.

## What will I do?

By the end of the course, you will be able to do the following:

- Demonstrate accuracy with French pronunciation.
- Speak fluently and confidently on familiar topics.
- Provide and request information in a range of contexts.
- Ask and answer questions using a combination of structures and expressions.
- Interpret information from a range of contexts and provide an appropriate response.
- Demonstrate confidence with formal and informal language.

## How will I be taught?

Group lessons consisting of presentations, group discussions, role plays, games, pair work and individual activities to cover all four skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening. Some 1-2-1 support will also be available.

## How will I be assessed?

Ongoing self, peer and tutor assessment of class work and homework, evidence for portfolios (if doing the Level 2 accreditation in Speaking and Listening).

## What could I progress on to?

- Next term of this course
- More confident holidays abroad
- More confidence in communicating in straightforward business contexts

## What equipment should I bring?

Pens, paper and dictionary. A course book will also be advised during induction.

## Will I gain a qualification?

Optional for September starters carrying on to July – NOCN Level 2 in Speaking and Listening.
