

Who is this course aimed at?

This is a leisure course which is suitable for anyone looking to start making fashion jewellery.

What will I need?

No formal qualifications required to join.

Programme Aims

This course is designed to help you attain the basics skills to design and make your own jewellery.

What will I do?

By the end of the course, you will be able to do the following:

- Identify the tools and materials needed to make jewellery
- Design and make earrings
- Attach clasps to stringing materials to make necklaces and bracelets
- Form decorative shapes from wire
- Calculate the cost of materials* so you can price jewellery projects
- Explore differing jewellery making techniques.

How will I be taught?

Group lessons consisting of demonstrations, practical activities, design projects, individual and group discussions. Some 1-2-1 support will also be available.

How will I be assessed?

Ongoing assessment of practical activities, activity record sheets, design projects and tutorials.

What could I progress on to?

- Courses for developing a business using your skills
- Informal learning groups and beading clubs
- Further study for a qualification at college level

What equipment should I bring?

Reading glasses (if you need them).

** Materials are provided, but if you intend to take the items you make home we would ask you to pay for the materials you have used. We try to keep material costs to a minimum, usually under £2.00 per item.*
