PRODUCTIVE SMALL GARDENS

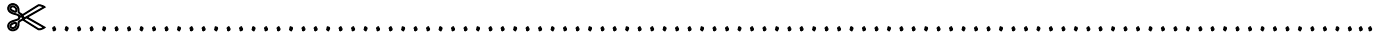
Friday 23 March 2012
