

4. Car Parking Provision

The car parks on the County Hall Campus are individually numbered for ease of identification.

The following is a list of the car parks available for public use:

Car Park No. 3 – Visitor Parking

This car park is solely for use by visitors and is located to the south of the Record Office

Car Park No. 6 – Disabled Parking

Located on the hard standing near the front entrance to County Hall

Car Park No. 7 East (only) – Staff/Countryside Visitor Overspill Parking

Located adjacent to the Country Park car park

The travel routes around County Hall have been designed to direct visitors towards the main entrance from Spetchley Road. The entrance to County Hall from the A4440 dual carriageway is primarily for use by staff who are familiar with the site.

Although some signage has been installed directing visitors to the Visitors Car Park from this direction, it is not to the same extent as that directing visitors from Spetchley Road.

Signage throughout the County Hall Campus

Signage is provided throughout the site to direct staff, visitors and deliveries to their correct destination.

The main road signs from the dual carriageway and Spetchley Road end direct all visitors and service vehicles to enter County Hall via the Spetchley Road entry point.

The main signage directs delivery vehicles and people with a disability to travel through the Delivery Road barrier towards the Loading Bay and the Hard Standing at the front of County Hall.

The signage also directs visitors for both County Hall and Wildwood to the Visitors Car Park by the side of the Record Office.

3. Access Control

Please note: Access control of the site and car parks at County Hall is maintained by barrier systems.

There are two forms of barrier control:

Blockers (Sunk into the road)

These are in place to control through traffic across the campus between Spetchley Road and Wildwood Drive. They also discourage public use of the campus car parks for visits to other buildings such as the hospital. The blockers allow access onto the site but restrict access off – a staff access pass or token from Reception is required for exit.

Arm barriers

An arm barrier system is in place for the Visitor car parking area. This does not restrict entry but, like the blockers, restricts access out of the car parks. The barrier on the Visitor Car Park allows exit with a token only. Exit requires a token issued by Reception.
