It can be seen that over the last 10 years an average of around a net 1,300 persons per annum are moving into the county. In general there is a substantial level of in-migration into the districts of Bromsgrove, Malvern Hills and Wychavon, and substantial out-migration from Redditch and Worcester City.

The net inflow from internal migration has decreased markedly, especially in the last three years. The decreases are especially noticeable in Bromsgrove, Wychavon and Malvern Hills.

It is also noticeable that international migration changed from a net outflow in 2001-06 to a net inflow for the years 2006-09, then a net outflow again in 2009-10. This fluctuation is probably due to economic factors, which affect the level of in-migration from overseas, although there is no equivalent decrease in international migration in either the national or the regional figures.
