

### Schools' Library Service will provide:

- Bulk loans of fiction and national curriculum non-fiction to teachers or schools and other educational establishments (including home educators)
- National curriculum bulk loans for pre-school groups
- Special loan facilities
- Delivery and collection service for most types of loans
- Displays of book-related work on SLS mobile libraries

### Advice, support and resources are also provided by the Schools' Library Service:

- To support all aspects of school library establishment, development and maintenance
- In selection of national curriculum and reading material
- On books and reading development within the school community
- For school reading groups
- For teachers for on-going library skills programmes in school



### Public Libraries will provide:

- Books, information and other materials to individual children, parents and teachers
- General advice about books and reading
- Visits by library staff to schools
- Group visits to local public library
- Where possible, offer display and exhibition facilities for school children
- Services to preschool groups including book collections, story times and visits
- An opportunity to reserve books
- A collection and return point for SLS loans
- Reading groups/ book clubs
- Holiday and out of school activities
- Where possible, a mobile library stop by schools in rural areas
