## Forecast Methodology

### Basis of Forecasts

Since LAs use different methods to forecast pupil numbers and take different factors into account, Regulations require LAs to provide a statement to accompany the forecast pupil numbers explaining the method by which the forecast is made. Set out below is the type of information, which we should expect to be covered.

### Sources of data

e.g. health authority; population census; pupil numbers (are these based on January Annual School Census or NOR as reported by schools at a different time of year?); estimates from individual schools (how are schools expected to derive these? What guidance are they given?)

Pre-school numbers from Health Authority data annual export plus actual NOR at schools as at January Annual School Census.

### How the raw data are processed to arrive at final figures

Information on any adjustment factors used together with a brief description of how these have been derived e.g. wastage rates from year group cohorts and post-16 staying-on rates - what rates have been applied?

Over how many years have the data been built up? What assumptions underlie the figures?

6 years of historical NOR data and pre school numbers used to calculate 5 year average intake rates at point of entry and points of transfer (note Worcestershire has some three-tier systems of first, middle and high schools). Average cohort survival rate also applied to show year group to year group changes. Average Post-16 staying on rate calculated over same 5 year period and assumed to continue.

**Additional factors allowed for**

e.g. housing developments; existing Academies; proposed Academies; boundary changes; expected migration; rationalisation proposals; age of transfer changes; error margins.

In each case the amount should be quantified, even if only an estimate, and the rationale for such allowances outlined.

Housing growth is not explicitly included, forecasts are based on current known pupils and pre-school children. Countywide forecasts have been demonstrated to be accurate to 1%+/- for following year actuals. There is one existing Academy in Worcester District offering 180 places per year, which is excluded from the forecast figures. No Academies due to open but some Worcestershire schools have registered interest in current Government proposals. No boundary changes to take account of.

**Potential variations**

If any of the above factors have been disregarded in assembling the forecasts provided, any likely or potential changes should be mentioned, with an estimate, however tentative, of their effect.

We do not expect the new Academies programme to impact surplus places very much. Those schools registering an interest are generally already popular schools with few surplus places so unless they expand significantly they will not offer any additional places.

**LA no. 885**

**Primary Schools over 25% surplus with at least 30 surplus places**

**Catshill First School & Nursery (2015)**

This school is geographically isolated from the rest of the town by the motorway so access to alternative provision is difficult. The most recent Ofsted inspection in December 2008 graded the school as Satisfactory. The Published Admission Number will reduce from 45 to 30 from September 2010. Accommodation at the school will be reviewed in light of this.

**Westlands First School (2035)**

This school serves a deprived area in Droitwich which is geographically separated from the rest of the town by a busy road. The most recent Ofsted inspection in February 2007 graded the school as Satisfactory. Housing growth is expected in the town within 5 years so the LA is not looking to remove places at this time.

**Honeybourne First School (2078)**

This is a small, rural school serving the village of Honeybourne and surrounding area. The most recent Ofsted inspection in July 2009 graded the school as Good. Numbers do fluctuate from year group to year group but pre-school numbers are stable.

**Pebworth First School (2118)**

This is a small, rural school serving an area at the edge of the County. The most recent Ofsted inspection in June 2009 graded the school as Satisfactory. Numbers fluctuate from year to year but the expected intake for September 2010 will maintain the current numbers. The school is currently exploring options for establishing a federation with another local school and the LA will discuss future provision for this area.

**Cherry Orchard 1<sup>st</sup> School (2121)**

This school has one particularly low year group. Expected intake in September 2010 will reduce the level of surplus places. The most recent Ofsted inspection graded the school as Satisfactory.

**Woodrow First School (2137)**

This school serves a deprived area of Redditch. The most recent Ofsted inspection in March 2010 graded the school as Good. The Published Admission Number has been reduced to 45 from September 2010 and accommodation will be reviewed in light of this.

**Gorse Hill C.E. Primary School (2167)**

This school serves a deprived area of Worcester. The most recent Ofsted inspection in May 2010 graded the school as Satisfactory. There is pressure for reception places in Worcester and the expected intake for September 2010 will reduce the number of surplus places.

**Moon's Moat First School (2192)**

There are smaller year groups at the top of the school but recent intakes have been higher so the number of surplus places is reducing. The expected intake for September 2010 will reduce the surplus further. The most recent Ofsted inspection in December 2009 graded the school as Satisfactory.

#### **Birchen Coppice Primary School (2905)**

This school was converted from a First school into a Primary school in September 2007. The school serves a deprived area of Kidderminster. The most recent Ofsted inspection in January 2010 graded the school as Satisfactory. There is pressure for reception places in Kidderminster at present and so the LA is not considering removing places at this time.

#### **Westacre Middle School (2916)**

This Middle school currently has two particularly small year groups. One of these is due to leave this summer and the intake for September 2010 is expected to be considerably higher so this will reduce the level of surplus places. Housing growth is expected in the town within 5 years so the LA is not looking to remove places at this time.

#### **Cleeve Prior C of E 1<sup>st</sup> School (3020)**

This is a small rural school. The most recent Ofsted inspection in February 2008 graded the school as Satisfactory. Pupil numbers do vary year on year and the expected intake for September 2010 is significantly higher than in recent years.

#### **Eckington C.E. First School (3038)**

This is a small, rural school. The most recent Ofsted inspection in March 2009 graded the school as Good. Expected intake for September 2010 will reduce surplus places.

#### **St Richard's C.E. First School (3042)**

The Published Admission Number has been reduced to 60 from September 2010 and accommodation will be reviewed in light of this. There are a number of temporary classrooms on site which are due to be removed. The most recent Ofsted inspection graded the school as Satisfactory.

#### **St Bartholomew's CE Primary (3012)**

This school opened in September 2007 following a reorganisation of schools in the wider area. Its most recent Ofsted inspection graded the school as Satisfactory.

#### **Cutnall Green C.E. 1<sup>st</sup> School (3316)**

This is a small, rural First school. There is a particularly small year group at the top of the school which will leave this summer. The expected intake for September 2010 is much larger and consequently will reduce the level of surplus places. The most recent Ofsted inspection in November 2007 graded the school as Good.

#### **St Mary's C of E (VA) Primary School (3331)**

This school is currently subject to Special Measures following an Ofsted inspection in November 2009 which graded the school as Inadequate. The most recent monitoring visit showed satisfactory progress and standards are

improving. There is a high pupil population in this part of Kidderminster so these spaces are needed. The surplus places are concentrated at the top of the school and should reduce over the next few years as these year groups leave and larger cohorts are admitted.

#### **Longdon St Mary's CE Primary (3352)**

This is a small Voluntary Aided school in a rural area of the County which is experiencing very low birth rates. The current head teacher is due to leave and discussions are to be held with the Governing Body and Diocesan authorities over the future of the school. The most recent Ofsted inspection in June 2010 graded the school as Good.

#### **St Joseph's Catholic School (3358)**

This is the only Catholic school in Malvern. The most recent Ofsted inspection in May 2009 graded the school as Good. Pupil numbers in the area are low and so discussions are planned with the Governing Body and Catholic Diocese regarding the future of the school. The expected intake for September 2010 is somewhat higher than previous years.

#### **Grove Primary School (3400)**

This school was formed by the amalgamation of a separate Infant and Junior school in September 2007. The Published Admission Number will be reduced to 45 from September 2010 and a programme of building works to support the amalgamation is ongoing. There is some temporary accommodation on site which may be removed. The most recent Ofsted inspection in June 2009 graded the school as Good.

#### Secondary Schools over 25% surplus with at least 30 surplus places

#### **Arrow Vale Community High School (4034)**

This is a National Challenge school and a new executive head has recently been appointed. The Published Admission Number will reduce to 224 from September 2011 and accommodation on site will be reviewed in light of this. The most recent Ofsted inspection in June 2008 graded the school as Satisfactory. Housing growth is expected in Redditch but details will not be available until Redditch Borough Council has evaluated the impact of the abolition of the Regional Spatial Strategy.

#### **Catshill Middle School (4402)**

This Middle school serves a deprived area of the town and is geographically isolated from the rest of Bromsgrove by the motorway so access to alternative provision is difficult. The Published Admission Number has been reduced to 90 from September 2010 and accommodation at the school will be reviewed in light of this. The most recent Ofsted inspection in February 2008 graded the school as Satisfactory.

#### **Simon De Montfort Middle Sch (4409)**

This school came out of Special Measures at its last Ofsted inspection and is now graded Satisfactory. The head teacher of the neighbouring high school is now also executive head of Simon De Montfort Middle. The Published Admission

Number will reduce to 150 from September 2011 and accommodation will be reviewed in light of this.

**Trinity High School (4437)**

Accommodation at this school is to be reviewed following the reduction of the Published Admission Number to 252 from September 2009 and provision of a new Design and Technology area. Housing growth is expected in Redditch but details will not be available until Redditch Borough Council has evaluated the impact of the abolition of the Regional Spatial Strategy.
