Crossings:



Uncontrolled Crossing in Alvechurch

Uncontrolled Crossing:

Dropped kerbs with buff coloured tactile paving.

Pedestrian Refuge:

Dropped kerbs and tactile paving with refuge placed in centre of carriageway to enable users to cross busy single carriageways one lane at a time.



Pedestrian Refuge at Bromwich Road, Worcester



Zebra Crossing at Barnards Green Traffic Island, Malvern

Zebra Crossing:

Belisha beacons, road markings, dropped kerbs and red coloured tactile paving for use by pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.

Pelican Crossing:

Signalised crossing with call facility for use by pedestrians and dismounted cyclists. Dropped kerbs and red tactile paving.

Toucan Crossing, at Newtown Road, Worcester

Toucan Crossing:

Identical to a pelican crossing except that it is for use by pedestrians and cyclists when waiting and crossing.



Puffin crossing at A456, Hagley

Puffin Crossing: Signalised crossing with automatically activated pedestrian phases when a pedestrian approaches the crossing. Dropped kerbs and red tactile paving

Pavement Types:

Buff Coloured Tactile Paving:

Used at uncontrolled crossings.



Kassel Kerbing in front of shelter at bus stop in Tenbury

Kassel Kerbing:

Raised kerbing for improving the access onto buses.



Buff Tactile Paving at A442, Hampton Lovett

Red Coloured Tactile Paving:

Used at pelican, toucan and zebra crossings.

Pedestrian Paths:



Footway at Britannia Square, Worcester

Footway:

Commonly with widths of between 1.2m and 1.8m. Tarmaced strip with kerbing, for use by pedestrians. Footways Run alongside a carriageway.



Footpath at London Road, Worcester

Footpath:

For pedestrians only and situated away from the carriageway.
