



Worcestershire Compact Awards

On Monday, November 7, the Council Chamber at County Hall played host to Worcestershire's second Compact Awards ceremony.

80 people attended the awards which celebrate excellence in joint working between the public sector and voluntary organisations in partnership as well as promoting the fantastic projects taking place across the county in local communities. 24 nominations were received, all of which were commended and demonstrated a wide range of highly effective partnerships across the county.

The overall winner was the partnership between Nexus Housing a Worcester based Housing Association and West Mercia Police. Through effective engagement with a much wider range of partners they were able to turn a block of flats with multiple problems into a sought after and desirable place to live.
