#### Approach

#### Organisational boundary

We have included within our report GHG emissions all electricity, gas and transport fuel data for our own buildings, street lighting, fleet and staff mileage. We have also included municipal waste disposal within our figures, which contribute approximately just under half of our total GHG emissions.

We have also included data from our main outsourced contractors for fleet, waste and highways contracts and included, where possible, data for their buildings, fleet and staff mileage undertaken under the contracts with ourselves.

#### Targets

We do not have a target to reduce our GHG emissions, however we do have a Carbon Management Plan in place which has a target to reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 30% by 2016, from 2009/10 levels. A copy of the plan is available here:
