

Wyre Community Discovery Centre



Set within 6,000 acres of ancient semi natural woodland, this sustainably constructed building with views into the beautiful Wyre Forest is a unique venue for conferences, meetings and other functions. The Community Discovery Centre was opened in 2010 by the legendary Robert Plant and offers a flexible indoor space plus outside covered area with balcony.

- **Location** – easy access, approx 25 minutes from the M5 (junction 6), approx 5 miles from Kidderminster Railway Station and situated on local bus route.
- Stunning surroundings
- **Parking** – ample parking in our large visitors' car park
- **Building** – eco-friendly building
- Covered outside area and balcony with picnic tables (ideal for breaks)

The Centre's flexible indoor space has plenty of natural light (one long room 6.5m x 22m or 2 smaller rooms each 6.5 x 11m) for 80 people (seated) to 150 max.

The Sustainable Choice

It is an innovative and sustainable timber structure featuring many green technologies such as:

- ✓ Thermostatically controlled underfloor heating fuelled by a woodchip boiler
- ✓ Sedum roof acts as a natural insulator
- ✓ Rainwater recovery system takes excess rainwater to flush the toilets
- ✓ Biodigester and reedbed water filter systems purify the waste water which feeds the wildlife ponds
- ✓ Mineral wool insulates the building
- ✓ Attractive landscaped surroundings include a sensory garden
