Drug and Alcohol Misuse in Worcestershire: A Partnership Approach



Worcestershire Drug and Alcohol Action Team (DAAT) is a partnership made up of people from the following:

- Worcestershire County Council (Adult and Community Services, Children's Services)
- Worcestershire Primary Care Trust
- West Mercia Police
- Worcestershire and Herefordshire Youth Offending Service
- West Midlands Ambulance NHS Trust
- HM Prison Service
- Hereford and Worcester Fire and Rescue Service
- West Mercia Probation Trust
- Worcestershire Mental Health Partnership NHS Trust
- District Councils (Community Safety, Housing)

The role of Worcestershire DAAT is to have a positive impact on drug and alcohol related harm by implementing actions from local and national strategies.

Worcestershire DAAT has responsibility for:

- Planning and purchasing drug and alcohol services
- Ensuring services are accessible and of a high quality across Worcestershire
- Working with individuals, families and communities to resolve local drug or alcohol related issues
- Ensuring that individuals, families and communities have access to drug and alcohol education, information and updates on local progress

Worcestershire's Substance Misuse Strategy and Business Plan has the following priorities for delivery:

- Reducing drug and alcohol related deaths and ill health
- Reducing drug and alcohol related crime and disorder
