CENSUS HOLDINGS

Our copies of the census have been purchased from the Public Record Office. The Public Record Office's reference numbers are included amongst the information written on the box. These reference numbers have been used by those compiling the 1851 transcripts.

We have our own numbering system. The numbers which appear in this handlist are the ones we have given to the films. If there is no number against a particular place it may mean that we do not hold that film. This is particularly true of parishes on the borders with other counties. It may also mean that the place in question did not exist as a parish at the time of that census and is included in the returns of another parish. Where we have been able to find out we have included this information in the notes at the back of the handlist.

PARISH NAMES AND BOUNDARIES

PLEASE BEAR IN MIND THAT THERE ARE TWO DIFFERENT ADMINISTRATIONS RUNNING IN THE COUNTY. THE ECCLESIASTICAL ONE AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (CIVIL) ONE. A PARISH CAN THEREFORE BE AN ECCLESIASTICAL PARISH OR A CIVIL PARISH. THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TWO MAY NOT BE THE SAME. THEY MAY HAVE BEEN FORMED AT DIFFERENT DATES AND THEY MAY HAVE HAD DIFFERENT NAMES.

EG. TARDEBIGGE IS AN ECCLESIASTICAL PARISH BUT IT COMES UNDER THE CIVIL PARISH OF TUTNAL AND COBLEY.

ECCLESIASTICAL PARISH -

THIS SERVES ONLY AN ECCLESIASTICAL ROLE. IT IS NOT PART OF THE LOCAL ADMINISTRATION. THERE ARE MORE ECCLESIASTICAL PARISHES THAN CIVIL ONES.

CIVIL PARISH -

THIS IS PART OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION. IT IS NOT PART OF THE ECCLESIASTICAL SET UP, THOUGH THE TWO MAY HAVE THE SAME NAME.

EXTRA PAROCHIAL -

THIS REFERS TO SOME GEOGRAPHICAL AREAS WHICH WERE NOT ORGANISED AS PARISHES. MANY OF THESE AREAS WERE MADE INTO CIVIL PARISHES AROUND 1858. THESE CIVIL PARISHES HAD NO EFFECT ON THE ECCLESIASTICAL STATUS OF EXTRA PAROCHIAL AREAS.
