Brief Description of Decision	To increase Vacant Seat Prices and SevernCard prices in line with inflation.  Decision to approve (in consultation with Cabinet) which will come into effect on 4 September 2023						
Reason(s) For Decision	As part of the 2023/24 budget setting report Worcestershire County Council Cabinet resolved on 2 February 2023 to increase the price of Vacant Seats and SevernCard Prices by 10%.  This document confirms that with effect from 4 September 2023 the Assistant Director for Highways & Transport Operations within the Economy and Infrastructure Directorate in consultation with the Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Highways & Transport, will implement the agreed increases to Vacant Seat Prices and Severncard Prices  Worcestershire County Council undertakes an annual review of fees associated with its Vacant Seats and Severncard provision. The fees have not increased since 2012 / 2013.  However, challenges in the Transport sector have prompted this action.
