Brief Description of Decision	Approval to award construction contracts and enter into any other agreements necessary to progress delivery of the Kepax Bridge scheme within the agreed funding envelope
Reason(s) For Decision	The decision is necessary to progress the delivery of the scheme in accordance with the decision made by Cabinet on 22 September 2022. Cabinet authorised the Strategic Director for Economy and Infrastructure to award construction contracts within the funding envelope available which was £17.6m. This comprised £15.9m (for core costs eg design, land acquisition, materials, supervision, labour etc) from sources identified in the Capital Programme, and £1.7m (to cover the Quantitative Risk Assessment) from Economy and Infrastructure resources.
	It was not possible to award the main construction contract immediately following Cabinet largely due to uncertainty in the steel market, however, enabling work progressed in accordance with previous Cabinet approvals. During the enabling works, some costs identified within the Quantitative Risk Assessment (QRA) were realised and some risk was moved from the QRA to the core costs. As such the core costs have increased (to £17m) and the QRA has been reduced correspondingly.  The total estimated cost of the scheme remains within the
	funding envelope approved by Cabinet.  Having consulted the Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Economy, Infrastructure and Skills, in furtherance of the
