What is the Virtual School?

The Virtual School is here to help you.

You may have met your Learning Advocates within your PEP meetings.

We work with your school, social worker and carers to make sure that you have everything you need for your education.

We want you to have the best education possible and to find the different areas of support you may need to help with learning.

In Summer 2021, we appointed a Pre-school Learning Advocate. She supports children aged from 2 years old until they start in school.

Attainment/Progress

Primary school children did not receive SATs results in 2021 due to Covid-19 but all of you still did very well in your learning.

If you think you need extra help in school, then please let your teachers or carer know and we can try and make this happen.

<u>The PEP</u>

This stands for **Personal Education Plan and it provides information on your**

- your views
- future targets

All PEPs were completed each term (100%)
