FORWARD PLAN – NOTICE OF GENERAL EXCEPTION CABINET MEMBER DECISION

I am writing to you in relation to the following item which has been recently added to the Forward Plan for a decision by the Cabinet at its meeting on 21 July 2022:

Malvern Hills Art College

As you are aware, under access to information legislation, 28 days' public notice is normally required of any items that require a key decision to be made. Although this does not appear to be a key decision, for transparency and the avoidance of doubt I am notifying you that it appears to me, on the information I currently have, that for reasons of expediency and timing that a decision on the item must be taken by such a date that it has not been considered practicable to defer it.

As this Notice is made available to you and the public at least 5 working days before the intended Cabinet decision, there is no requirement for you to respond to this Notice nor to agree to the urgent consideration of it. The purpose of the Notice is to ensure that you are aware, in accordance with the constitutional rules, that the Cabinet will be asked to consider this item.
