DECISION:	Cabinet:  (a) Acknowledged the work to date on the Worcestershire Bus Service Improvement Plan (BSIP) and how this influences Worcestershire's Enhanced Partnership and Schemes;  (b) Approved in principle the draft Enhanced Partnership Plan and Schemes, which has been prepared in accordance with guidance from Central Government;  (c) Authorised the Strategic Director of Economy and Infrastructure, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Highways, to implement the Plan noting that the Enhanced Partnership Schemes are contingent on Department for Transport funding (to be announced) and results of the 28-day legal requirement consultation, and formulate operational schemes and policies with an appropriate implementation schedule having regard to the Plan;  (d) Authorised the commencement of a full review by the Strategic Director of
	Economy and Infrastructure of the Council's Passenger Transport

	network, which will incorporate all aspects of the public Transport network; and  (e) Noted that the Council has made a submission to the Department for Transport relating to the implementation of a Zero Emissions Bus Regional Area (ZEBRA).
