




Walk Worcestershire is a series of easy to use and well waymarked walks.

<b>Gates/Stiles</b>	10 gates, 0 stiles.
<b>Terrain</b>	Gentle slopes, can be muddy in places
<b>Refreshments</b>	The March Hare Inn and other local public houses.


## The Countryside Code

## Millennium Way Easy Access Circular

The Millennium Way Easy Access Circular is a category 3 tramper route\* and therefore offers an easy stile free walk in beautiful countryside, taking in the Parishes of Broughton Hackett and White Ladies Aston. Please note that sections of this route can be muddy in places.



## White Ladies Aston

The circular route takes you through the small village of White Ladies Aston, named after an order of nuns who were granted land within the Parish. The route passes St John the Baptist church situated in the village.
