Notice of Adoption of the Waste Core Strategy

In accordance with Regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012 notice is hereby given that the Worcestershire County Council Waste Core Strategy Local Plan Development Plan Document was adopted on15th November 2012. The Waste Core Strategy sets out the vision, objectives, strategy and policies to guide waste management related development in Worcestershire until 2027. It forms part of the Local Development Framework for Worcestershire and replaces some of those policies set out in the Worcestershire County Structure Plan (adopted June 2001). The Waste Core Strategy was considered by an Independent Inspector at Examination in March 2012. The Inspector's Report was published on 20th July 2012 and can be viewed at the locations set out below and on the County Council's website www.worcestershire.gov.uk/wcs. The adopted Waste Core Strategy incorporates the changes recommended by the Inspector.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- (a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

An application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than the end of the period of six weeks <u>of-starting with</u> the date of the adoption of the Core Strategy, i.e. by 27th December 2012.
