Thank you for forwarding the consultation for planning permission for the Proposed Sand and Gravel Quarry and Restoration Scheme at: Land at Lea Castle Farm, Near Wolverley, Worcestershire. We would like to reiterate that as we are not statutory consultees we would not routinely comment on this type of planning application.
