Unfortunately I don't cover the Wyre Forest District for Ramblers Association consultations. However I have blind copied this reply to a couple of people in the Worcestershire RA who may be able to help.

I had a very brief, desktop only, look at some of the supporting documents and was impressed with depth of treatment of, and proposals for, the PROW issues in the Non Technical Summary at sections 6 and the promises for additional PROW in section 7. If I had been replying for the RA I would have needed to read some of the other documents, probably make a site visit, and would have asked a firm commitments that any temporary closures needed were minimised and that the new PROW would be legally provided before restoration was completed.
