Many thanks for this, I would like to point out a few concerns.

Firstly I would like to point out that Broadwaters Sion Hill is within 2 KM of the site you mention. In fact I think you will find there are about 2000 houses in Broadwaters that are within the 2 KM radius.

None of the concerns that Cllr Rook and myself put forward have been incorporated into this paper.

Perhaps you need a map that has a 2 KM radius of the site and then you will see that there is a big residential area that is densely populated. We are within a 5 minute walk. I suggest that this is well within the 2 KM you mention. At the end of my road which is less than 100 yards will be able to see part of this development. I feel that this is an important fact as people forget us here. We are not out of sight and out of mind.
