Following our conversation I have had a think about condition wording if the scheme gains approval. Given that the revised restoration scheme plans do include the restoration of the wall, rather than my original suggested wording, the following should ensure the wall is reinstated properly:

**Notwithstanding the submitted details, prior to the commencement of the development hereby approved, a scheme for the part removal to create the vehicular access, protection and reinstatement of the historic boundary wall, shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Mineral Planning Authority. Thereafter, the development shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details.**
