With regard to Lea Castle Farm Quarry in reviewing the application I have noticed that the Environmental Statement and Planning Statement refers to 11 potential jobs being created (including the assessment in the Transport Chapter), but the Transport Statement refers to and has assessed 8 staff members being employed by the proposal (as the worst-case scenario).

I have asked the agent which figure is correct, 8 or 11. He has confirmed that it would be initial 8 jobs created rising to 11 jobs.

I note your comments refer to 8 staff on site.

Am I correct to assume your comments remain unchanged, even with this slight increase in staff numbers?
