Department Store

A warehouse store stocks large amounts of products normally in large sizes, you can sometimes sell on these products in convenience stores.



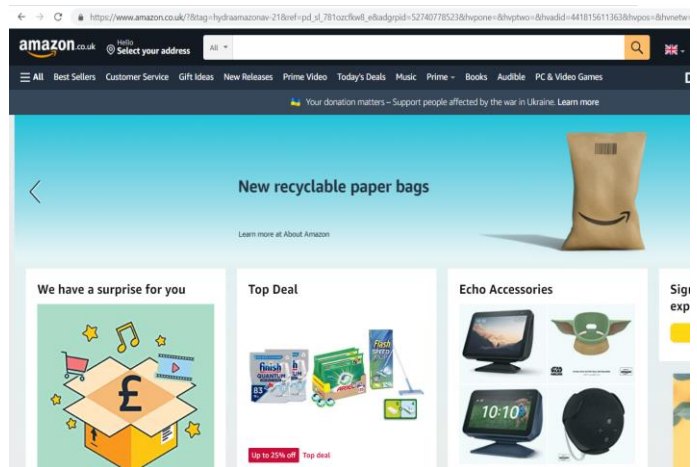
Outlet/ specialist store
