	This will result in the transfer of the service on 1 May 2015 and consequential transfer of staff (under TUPE) delivering the Internal Audit Service at the date of transfer at Worcestershire County Council to Warwickshire County Council subject to the finalisation of terms and conditions in the agreement.
	The agreement will be for an initial period of three years and will be automatically extended for a further 2 years unless there is a significant service failure.
