Brief Description Of Decision	Following Cabinet meeting on 7 th March 2013, permission was granted to publish Full Proposals to increase the PAN at Bengeworth CE First School from 60 to 90 within 12 months of the Cabinet date. Subsequent to these proposals, if no objections were received within the statutory representation period, the Director of Children's Services be authorised to progress the proposals.
Reason(s) For Decision	The representation period started on 9 th September 2013 and closed on 4 th October 2013. Within that period no objections were received and so the decision to proceed with the PAN increase can go ahead in line with the Cabinet approval.
Alternative Options Considered And Rejected	Bengeworth PAN increase was part of a series of options following meetings with Headteachers in the area and a public consultation. It was felt that this increase was the best option to meet the identified need. Other options considered, included: • Bussing children to rural schools • Using existing school accommodation but not in prefe3rred area.
