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What's gone well since last report?

- Sam has been out to re-visit some supported living services alongside members of the Pathway Planning Team and has been asking people how they have liked living there. He has written a report about his findings so far.
 - Verity Almond has started in the housing project officer role and will be based in the Pathway planning team. Her priorities to start with will be managing voids, supporting social workers with finding placements and tendering for some new shared supported living services.
 - Several new shared supported living services have been tendered and are due to be ready in early 2023.
 - Work continues on the new supported living contract and specification, we hope to be able to share this with our having a place to live group at the next meeting.
