Subgroup:	Right Support for Carers
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What's gone well since last report?

- Right Support for Carers met on 6th December, 2022. The meeting covered Carer Voice updates including: dates for the diary, roles for representatives available, and work that is developing in Carer Voice for example training for reps and experts by experience.
- Fran Kelsey led a discussion about Right Support for Carers Aims and priorities. An engagement session is planned to explore this in more detail.
- Some of the topics we are discussing include: specialist dentistry services and how carers can be involved in feeding back on this.
- Feedback was given on Care Contributions and an update from the last LDPB and working together on this.

- Obesity and healthy eating remains on the agenda and where this would be best picked up through the Big Aims of the strategy as there is a lot to think about in tackling this issue.
- Quality Health Checks (including 14-18 year olds). We are hearing mixed experiences from carers about annual health checks. It is important that all individuals get a good quality annual health check. Carers are pleased that lots of positive work is happening to achieve this, and working towards good quality Health Action Plans.
