Brief Description Of Decision	<p>The Cabinet member for Highways has</p> <p>(a) Approved the proposals to implement civil enforcement of the bus lanes at Lowesmoor, Worcester pursuant to the Transport Act 2000, Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers</p> <p>(b) Agreed the level of penalty charge proposed in the report in relation to bus lane and bus gate contraventions</p> <p>(c) Approved the publicity proposals</p> <p>(d) Appointed the Council's representative to become a member of the PATROL (Parking and Traffic Regulation Outside London) Joint Service Committee in order for WCC to access independent adjudication through the Bus Lane Adjudication Joint Service – the Council's representative will be the Cabinet Member for Highways.</p>
Reason(s) For Decision	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be able to enforce the bus lane which runs through Lowesmoor in Worcester in order to minimise delays to an important bus route through to the Hospital • Joining PATROL Joint Service Committee enables the Council to access the independent Bus Lane Adjudication Joint Service, fulfilling a requirement of carrying out enforcement
Alternative Options Considered And	Not to enforce the bus lane – rejected as the congestion causes significant delays to critical bus services impacting the economic viability of these commercial services
