Worcestershire County Council has published proposed "Main" and "Additional" changes to the submitted Waste Core Strategy for Worcestershire for public comment. The Inspector will take these documents into account when considering whether the Core Strategy complies with the legal requirements and is "sound".

The consultation will run from 5th April until 5:30pm on 21st May 2012. It is important that you reply before the consultation ends. Late representations will not be forwarded to the Inspector.
