Purpose:	To consider the publication of the proposed revised Education Planning Obligations Policy following a formal public consultation process.

	<b>publication of data from 2021 Census to update the 'pupil yield' figure.</b>
Reason(s) for the Decision:	As set out in the report. To set out the approach the Council will take in assessing the impact of new housing developments on schools and early education provision to ensure it fulfils its statutory duty of providing sufficient school places for all children aged 4-19 resident in the county wishing to attend a publicly-funded school and that all 3 and 4 year olds (and all eligible 2 year olds) can access high quality, free early education places either in school or private provision.
Alternative Options Considered:	Consultation on the proposed policy will begin in January 2019 for a six week period with final policy approval being delegated to the Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Education and Skills, in consultation with the Director.
