Brief Description Of Decision	Approval of the School Admissions Policy for Community & Voluntary Controlled Schools 2018/19 and the Co-ordinated Admission Schemes 2018/19.
Reason(s) For Decision	The School Admissions Code of Practice makes it a mandatory requirement for admission authorities to determine their admission arrangements annually and even where no changes are made and consultation is not required, they must still be formally approved.
Alternative Options Considered And Rejected	None considered. Changes to the School Admissions Code are mandatory and as such admission authorities <u>must</u> make the necessary changes to existing policies and any proposed policies. No significant changes to the policy for Community and Voluntary Controlled Schools in Worcestershire have been put forward and therefore the proposal was to adopt the same policy/schemes for 2018/19 as were approved for 2017/16.
