	Five responses were received during the representation period. There were no objections.
Alternative Options Considered And Rejected	Information on increasing demand for first school places was shared with schools in the autumn term 2013. These three schools came forward and were included in the public consultation during the spring term 2014. Alternative options suggested as part of the consultation were: (a) Build a new school for the new housing (b) Relocate and expand Millfields First School onto a new site (c) Expand Sidemoor First School. (d) Utilise spare capacity in village schools When considering the alternative options suggested the Council weighed up the number of places required, the quality and diversity of current provision and value for money of options to deliver these places. Cabinet endorsed the proposals as published for the reasons set out in the report of 10 th April.
