Additional Funding Requests

If you wish to make a request for Additional Funding this must be recorded on the PEP in the "My Targets" section and linked to a SMART target. Following a discussion with your Learning Advocate they will seek approval for the funding from the Virtual School Head. Once approved a notification will appear on the PEP and your Learning Advocate will contact you to let you know that the funding has been approved. You are advised to not start the intervention that requires the additional funding until you have received confirmation of approval from the Virtual School to ensure that you will receive the funding.
