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Early Years Bulletin: Worcestershire News and Reminders

Worcestershire Children's Services

Last Friday, Ofsted published its <u>report</u> following a full inspection of Worcestershire Children's Services in May. We are delighted to share that we have received a 'Good' rating. Ofsted inspectors noted that there has been continued progress since the last inspection in 2019 and found that "there is a coordinated drive to continue to improve children's experiences" which is testament to the hard work of our colleagues in children's services and the recognition of the importance of the partnership and impact of schools and settings on keeping children safe was recognised.

Nursery Education Funding

Provider Agreement 2023/24

Early Years Funding Consultation

The DfE have launched a Funding Consultation, seeking views on their proposed approach to funding for early years entitlements for **2-year-olds and under from April 2024**. The consultation focuses on the way the funding will be distributed to local authorities, as well as how local authorities deliver the funding to early years providers.

New First School for Redditch

In order to meet the increased demand for school places that has arisen due to local housing developments, Worcestershire County Council is proposing to deliver a new First School, including a nursery and wraparound provision, in the Webheath area of Redditch. The school will be located on a site off Foxyldiate Lane and will ensure that child can access a First School place within their local community.

Summer activity pack to encourage children to wash their hands

Continuing the promotion of the 'Clean Hands, Safe Hands' campaign. Public Health in Worcestershire has put together a summer holiday activity pack to help encourage children to wash their hands. It is aimed at children in early years and primary school and includes activities such as 'colour in an ugly bug', a maze and a wordsearch. There is also an opportunity for children to design their own ugly bug and send it in to us. Public Health will create a gallery of ugly bugs and use the best ones in our next handwashing campaign in the autumn.

All ugly bugs designed should be returned to public health by Monday 4th September 2023. EHCNA Request

When making an Education Health and Care Needs Assessment request, please note that although it shows that you have 15 days to complete the request, each time you save the applications the 15 days restarts; this allows you to complete the form over a longer period.
