Brief Description of Decision	 Approves the increase in number of pupils for September 2023 to: (i) 220 at Rigby Hall Special School; (ii) 354 at Wyre Forest Special School; and (iii) 256 for at Fort Royal Special School. To note the details of the representations made in response to the public notices and full proposals for the school organisation changes at above special schools, due to increased demand for places.
Reason(s) for Decision	Demand for more special school places across Worcestershire for September 2023.
Alternative Options Considered and Rejected	The option of doing nothing or delaying delivery of Special School provision proposed is not feasible. It poses great risk to the Council in it not providing sufficient statutory school places and to parents in their not being able to secure a school place for their child(ren) within their local area.
