Rachel read out the report (Appendix 1).



Comments/Questions:

Fran said the link to the Dental Survey can been sent to providers.

Morag explained that Herefordshire and Worcestershire are the first areas to roll out the Oliver McGowan Training – there is a bit more work to be done before the training can be delivered. There were some issues with the paperwork being sent after the training.

Jenny asked about carer involvement in the Oliver McGowan training and asked how carers can help. Morag said the training is quite specific in terms of delivery – it must be delivered by a co-trainer with a Learning Disability, an Autistic co-trainer and a subject matter expert trainer. As the training develops towards tiers 2 and 3 delivery, there may be scope for carer involvement.

Jenny said Worcestershire Association of Carers will help share the Dental Survey and will add the link to their website. Jenny asked if carers could also fill out the survey. Morag said this would be helpful, noting that the survey is about the experience of people with Learning Disabilities receiving dental services.

Having a Place to Live

Having a Place to Live

Sam read out the report (Appendix 2).

Fran asked if Sam and Adam would like an agenda slot at a future Partnership Board to discuss Supported Living in more detail. Sam and Adam said this would be good.

Sandra asked if Sam visited the smaller supported living homes as well. Sam said he could visit the smaller cluster flats – there would need to be some discussion around this.

Jenny asked if there were any plans to reinstate the quality checkers team – they used to undertake quality checks in peoples' homes. Catherine said the team still exists and she has been doing reviews over the phone. Experts by Experience haven't been able to go back out to visit since Covid. Catherine said she doesn't know if there is going to be a return to in-person visits. Jenny asked if there was some way that these visits could be expanded as so much more was picked up during the peer visits. Fran said she

will speak to Becci Hook, Quality Assurance Manager, and bring an update to a future Partnership Board.

Sandra said it is important that these visits are undertaken - she is aware of someone who is living in a flat with mould. Adam asked Sandra to send him the details and he will look into this.

Fran said the social workers are still regularly reviewing people and the Quality Assurance Team does detailed quality monitoring of providers.

Kelly Palmer – Principal Social Worker - Introduction

Kelly went through her presentation (Appendix 6)



Comments/Questions:

Martin asked Kelly what success looks like and how will she measure this. What issues is the Principal Social Worker trying to tackle. Kelly explained that she will be looking at the roles and responsibilities of the Principal Social Worker and how these are being met at present. Kelly explained that the role has been in place in legislation since 2014 looking at practice oversight, but this is the first time in Worcestershire that it is a dedicated post. The benefit for Worcestershire will be having

someone who isn't directly attached to a team who can look at oversight and be able to challenge.

Jenny asked if the role is across the whole of social care. Kelly confirmed that the role is across the whole of adult social care. Teams have been invited to reflective sessions.

Sandra asked Kelly if recruitment and retention of social work staff comes under her remit. Kelly said recruitment comes under the Heads of Service but part of her role will be looking at staff wellbeing and how we can retain and support staff.

Partnership Board thanked Kelly for attending and said she is welcome to come back at any time.



Hear Me Now – Lorenzo Gordon & Huw Jones (Maldaba)

Lorenzo went through his presentation (Appendix 7).

Hear Me Now is an App that can go onto Apple and Android tablets, laptops and mobile phones.

It has been designed for people with learning disabilities and is individual to each person.

Comments/Questions:

Lucy asked about the cost. Lorenzo said they are waiting for Herefordshire & Worcestershire Integrated Care Board and the County Council for the go ahead and from that point it will be free.

Lucy said it is similar to the hospital passport. Lorenzo said yes it is similar. There is a bit in the App called About Me and this section will have the same layout for everyone but the information put into that section will be personal to the individual.

Fran asked if there was somewhere on the App that could be used to show information about needs when travelling e.g. on buses. Lorenzo said yes – any information can be stored on it. It doesn't have to be connected to the internet all the time to work – you can show people information already downloaded and you can take it with you anywhere and use it to show people what they need to know about you. Huw said people have used the App to put in specific travel instructions – e.g., I would like to get off at this stop.

Lucy said there are some people who cannot use technology and asked if there was a paper version. Lorenzo said one of the reasons they created the App was because of issues with paper versions. There are similar types of paper versions like the hospital passport.

Catherine asked how and when it would be rolled out. Lorenzo said they will definitely be rolling it out and it is supported by NHS England. A series of engagement sessions are being held for frontline staff. There is a delivery team that will support the roll out and Aimee is the link for this. There is some promotional information and they are working to create easy read versions of the information.

Fran said that Richard Keble (HWICB) is also a key link.
