Influences on outcomes for children

Risk factors that can threaten children's development, limit future social and economic opportunities, and increase the likelihood of mental and physical health problems, criminal involvement, substance misuse, or exploitation or abuse in later life. These factors exist at different levels within the child's environment – at the individual, family, community and society level – and interact in complex ways.

Impact of intervention in the Early Years

Adverse early life experiences can have lasting effects across the life course, sustaining inequalities and resulting in negative consequences for the health and wellbeing of individuals and society.
