What is a supported internship?

A supported internship is a type of study programme specifically aimed at young people aged 16 to 24 with a EHCP who wish to move into employment. The internships provide the opportunity for young people to achieve sustained, paid employment by equipping them with the skills they need for work, through learning in the workplace.

Who are they for?

- Are 16 to 24 years old with SEND
- Have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)
- Want to find a job

Aims of a Supported Internship:

- Supporting students to develop the skills valued by employers
- Enabling students to demonstrate their value in the workplace
- Developing confidence in students own abilities to perform successfully at work
