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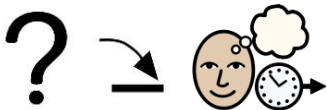
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What are T Levels

T Levels are an alternative to A levels, apprenticeships and other 16 to 19 courses.

T Levels focus on vocational skills and can help students into skilled employment, higher study or apprenticeships.



What to expect:

- > T-levels are two-year courses
- > They are equivalent to three A-levels
- > Placements are at least 315 hours
- > Your time is split: 80% classroom learning; 20% industry placement
- > T-levels could help you get into skilled employment, further study or a higher apprenticeship

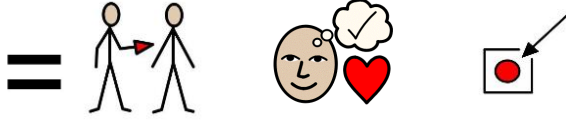

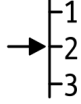
