

What is an A Level?

A Level are sometimes called General Certificates of Education or Advanced levels and are normally studied after GCSEs. AS levels generally take one year to complete, and A levels are studied across two years. A levels subject-based qualifications that can lead to university, further study, training, or work. All A levels have points called UCAS points attached to them.
