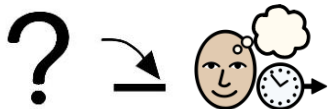


WHAT IS... A DEGREE



What is a Degree?

A degree is an academic course and qualification studied for and attained at university. The most popular degree is an undergraduate degree known as a Bachelor's Degree and most take three to four years to complete. The highest classification of degree you can achieve is a First-Class Honours.



What to expect:

- > Degrees are subject focused and there are many different options available.
- > Degrees are assessed by a mix of exams, assignments and projects.
- > Most degrees require applicants to hold A levels or level three vocational qualifications and you will need to apply by the January before you want to start.
- > In England, students have to pay for their degrees.

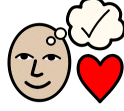
