Statement of Reasons for proposing to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER (A38, WORCESTER TO TEWKESBURY ROAD, WORCESTER) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (NO.4) ORDER 1997 (REVOCATION) AND (A38 WORCESTER ROAD, WORCESTER) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

Worcestershire County Council have made this Order for facilitating the safe passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic and for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER
(A38, WORCESTER TO TEWKESBURY ROAD, WORCESTER)
(40 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 4) ORDER 1997

Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 of and part iv of schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby order as follows:-

- 1. The County of Hereford and Worcester (A38 Worcester to Tewkesbury Road, Worcester (De-Restriction) (No.1) Order 1985 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though the length of road detailed in Article 1 was amended as follows:-

 " That length of the A38 Worcester to Tewkesbury road in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester which extends from a point 698 metres south-west of its junction with Elm Green Close for a distance of 155 metres in a south westerly direction shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act of 1984".
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the A38 Worcester to Tewkesbury Road, Worcester in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester from a point 58 metres south west of its junction with Elm Green Close for a distance of 640 metres in a southerly direction.
- 3. This Order may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (Worcester to Tewkesbury Road, Worcester) (40 M.P.H Speed Limit) (No.4) Order 1997 and shall come into operation on the 28th day of April 1997

THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER (A38 WORCESTER TO TEWKESBURY ROAD, WORCESTER) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1997

On 17 April 1997 Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order which will introduce a 40 mph speed limit on the A38 Worcester to Tewkesbury Road, Worcester from a point 58 metres south west of its junction with Elm Green Close for a distance of 640 metres in a southerly direction.

A copy of the Order, relevant map, Statement of Reasons for making the Order and affected existing regulations may be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, WR5 2NP during normal office hours.

The validity of the Council's powers in making the Order or this exercise of them may be questioned by application to the High Court by 29 May 1997.
