




2 step verification

Two-step verification (sometimes called two-step authentication) helps protect you by making it more difficult for someone else to sign in to your account. It uses two different forms of identity: your password, and a contact method (also known as security info).

Even if someone else finds your password, they'll be stopped if they don't have access to your security info. This is also why it's important to use different passwords for all your accounts.





2 step verification

Here is what it could look like when you complete a 2-step verification.

You will get a prompt pop up on your screen, you will then need to complete each step.


Add an extra layer of security
